M-DAY VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

Open to all eligible M-DAY Captains and Majors. If the selected Officer is from another state, the Officer must Interstate Transfer (IST) to the WYARNG for the duration of this assignment. Based on the selecting board's interview and the officer's records, the best candidate will be selected, regardless of rank.

POSITION: MAJ/O4, Deputy Team Chief, Defensive Cyber Ops Element

PARA/LIN: 238/01

LOCATION: JFHQ, Cheyenne

DUTIES: This position is a member of the Defensive Cyber Operations Element (DCO-E). The DCO-E's primary mission is to protect ARNG information assets and Information Systems against cyber threats and attacks. With proper authorization, the DCO-E also assists in the defense of mission partner networks. DCO-E will bring expertise in Assessment, Detection, Response and Recovery and Prevention procedures. The Deputy Team Chief position provides guidance, oversight and direction in all aspects of DCO-E operations. The Deputy Team Chief is responsible for all State DCO-E operations as well as being the focal point for inquiries from other National Guard DCO-Es, Department of Homeland Security, Wyoming Office of Homeland Security and other government agencies. Deputy Team Chief will:
Implement and enforce Defensive Cyber Operations (DCO) policies and procedures reflecting applicable laws, policies procedures and regulations.

- Manage the publishing of DCO guidance and Time Compliance Network Orders for the enclave constituency. Provide incident reports, summaries and other situational awareness information to higher headquarters.

- Manage an incident from inception to final remediation and after action reporting.

- Manage threat or target analysis of DCO information and production of threat or target information within the network.

- Manage the monitoring of external DCO data sources to maintain enclave situational awareness.

- Interface with external organizations (e.g. public affairs, law enforcement, Command) to ensure appropriate and accurate dissemination of incident and other DCO information.

- Coordinate with network owners and civilian partners.

- Lead risk analysis and management activities for the network or enclave environment.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Current Officers in OR able to become a member of the WYARNG.
2. Open to CPT/O3 and MAJ/O4
3. O1A/Branch Immaterial.
4. Must have or obtain within 6 months, one of the following IT MGT. Level II certificates: CAP, CASP, CCISO, CISM, CISSP, GSLC.
5. Must hold a TS/SCI security clearance or be capable of obtaining one.
