

# COVID-19: Screening Questionnaire

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## Mission

WYMD establishes guidelines to Army and Air Leadership that ensures service member safety during this COVID-19 pandemic.

## Commanders Intent

Army and Air leaders are able to develop a return to duty plan based on clearly established guidelines. This will allow for simultaneously ensuring readiness and mission success to be addressed internally and approved by the TAG.

## General Guidance

The Medical Working Group recommends the following COVID-19 illness screening questions to be completed 24-hours prior to reporting to duty:

Do you currently have any of the following:

- Fever (100.4 Fahrenheit or higher) or feeling feverish?
- Chills?
- A new or worsening cough not caused by another health condition?
- New or worsening difficulty breathing not caused by another health condition?
- Sore throat?
- New or worsening muscle aches not caused by another health condition?
- New or worsening headache that is not normal for you and not caused by another health condition?
- New loss of sense of taste or smell?

In the last 14 days, have you had close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or greater) with anyone with a positive or suspected COVID-19 infection?

In the last 14 days, have you tested positive for COVID-19?

Are you awaiting a COVID-19 test result?

**If the answers to any of these questions is “yes,” then the service member should not come to work and must contact their supervisor for guidance.**
